



## **Immunization Policy**

Our practice follows immunization guidelines recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

We strongly believe that all children must receive the recommended vaccines by AAP, Center of Disease Control (CDC) and Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

Vaccination throughout childhood is essential because it helps provide immunity before children are exposed to potentially life-threatening diseases. Vaccines are tested to ensure that they are safe and effective for children to receive at the recommended ages. Unimmunized children are at risk for severe communicable diseases which can be life-threatening. Unimmunized children in our waiting room may expose our patients to serious diseases such as chickenpox, measles, whooping cough, mumps and other diseases.

If you cannot comply with these standards, we will regretfully ask you to seek medical care with another physician whose philosophy meets your needs better.
